



# RESTORATION OF VOTING RIGHTS

For Convicted Felons



## RESTORING VOTING RIGHTS

Arkansas law affords persons convicted of a felony the unique opportunity to have their voting rights restored under certain conditions.

*Ark. Code Ann. Amend. 51 §11(d)(2)(A-D)*

## STEPS TO RESTORING VOTING RIGHTS

1: Obtain proof from the appropriate state or local agencies that all of the requirements have been completed OR proof that the record has been sealed.

2: Submit proof to the Voter Registration Department of the county clerk's office where the person convicted of a felony now resides.

3: Complete an Arkansas Voter Registration Application and return it to the Voter Registration Department of the county clerk's office.

## PROVIDE TO THE COUNTY CLERK

- discharged from probation or parole;
- paid all probation or parole fees;
- satisfied all terms of imprisonment;
- paid all applicable court costs, fines, or restitution

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## SEALING RECORDS

A right to petition the court to have a record sealed once the terms of sentence is completed (exceptions may apply.)  
Petitioning the court to seal a record does not guarantee it will be approved. There is no fee to file the petition to seal.

## STEPS TO SEALING A RECORD

1: Meet the following criteria:

- completed all parole and probation requirements;
- paid all court costs, fines, restitution, etc.

2: Download a Petition to Seal form from the Arkansas Crime Information Center website at [www.dps.arkansas.gov](http://www.dps.arkansas.gov). A copy can also be obtained by visiting the Court Records Department of the county clerk's office.

3: Complete the Petition to Seal form in its entirety and return it to the Court Records Department of the county clerk's office.
