CLERK'S OFFICE HOSTS VOTER REGISTRATION TRAINING FOR THE PUBLIC

(PULASKI, ARK.) – Pulaski County Clerk Terri Hollingsworth is organizing two voter registration training sessions to better equip organizations, churches, and civic groups with the information to register new applicants correctly.

As of August 1, the voter registration department has processed more than 1200 applications and anticipates an increase in registrations leading up to the October 7 deadline.

Topics will also cover how to properly fill out the new absentee application and how to prevent the spread of false election information. The training sessions are free and open to the public. Attendees must register in advance. The first session will be virtual through Zoom, and the second will be in person.
